Society's Assets is sponsoring a youth art contest. All entries become the property of Society's Assets and winning entries will be displayed at the agency's Holiday Banquet on Friday, December 2, 2005 at Roma Lodge in Racine. Students and their parents are welcome to attend. Entries may also be incorporated into agency materials.

All students that enter the contest will receive a gift. First (\$100), second (\$50), and third (\$25) place prizes will be awarded in each grade category. Contest entries must be received at the Society's Assets main office in Racine by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 14, 2005. The office is located at 5200 Washington Avenue, Suite 225, Racine, WI 53406. CONTEST DETAILS

1. Entrants **must** live in the Society's Assets service area of Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Rock, or Jefferson counties.
2. Students in kindergarten through 12th grade are eligible.
3. Entries **must** be submitted on the 8 1/2" x 11" official ENTRY BLANK, or a copy of it. Both sides must be completed. Students in grades 9 - 12 **may choose** to submit their entries on a 22" X 28" sheet of paper with the 8 1/2" X 11" Entry Blank (with the information section completed) attached to the back. Only artwork matching these two sizes will be considered by the judges.
4. Entries **must** include the theme words "Ability. . .Not Disability" as part of the artwork to meet judging criteria. **No** other words should be included.
5. The poster must be created using a two-dimensional medium. More than one medium can be used, i.e. pencil and crayon, paint and marker, etc.
6. Computer-generated work is acceptable, but must be limited to less than 50 percent of the finished product.
7. Judges will review the entries to ensure directions are followed and then to rate for uniqueness and composition.
